What is it?

The Brightmoor Community Greenhouse provides an early season plant-propagation space for family, market, and community gardens of all sizes.

How does it work?

- 1. Fill out a <u>Greenhouse Invoice Form</u> or <u>Greenhouse Membership Form</u>. Each time you drop off trays or purchase supplies, you will add it to your form.
- 2. Fill out a row for any trays or soil purchased and place in the folder.
- 3. Pay your rental/supply fees. This can be paid online at neighborsbuildingbrightmoor.com by clicking the "donate" button. Include "Greenhouse Rental" in the special instructions.
- 4. Refer to the **Greenhouse Guide** then seed and drop-off your trays.
- 5. Use the sign-in sheet to show that you have added new trays.
- 6. The greenhouse will water, heat, and care for your seedlings.
- 7. Pick up trays when ready (usually 4 weeks).
- 8. We can also do custom-grown orders. Contact the greenhouse manager for order form or quotes.
